10.8 Source Head Removal

The following procedure outlines the source head removal. The head should be removed to perform maintenance on the Tube, Shutter, and to replace the Source Window:

- 1. Power-Off the AAU by removing the power cord from the APC Battery Backup. Follow your site "Lock-Out" procedure to ensure the power cord is not plugged back in until this procedure is completed.
- 2. Open the Source Head side cover by removing the six Phillips screws and disconnect the source head harness (j/p 22), the blue filament cable (see 10.8.1) and the orange Air Line.
- 3. Open the door to the SSIU panel.
- 4. Disconnect the High Voltage Lead and green Ground-wire from the High Voltage Power Supply. (see 10.8.2)
- 5. Remove the nuts securing the sub-panel within the SSIU. Once the four nuts have been removed, pull the sub-panel from the four threaded studs and swing the sub-panel toward the drive side of the SSIU.
- 6. Using a 1 1/8" socket wrench, remove the two bolts holding the Source Head to the unit. (be careful not to drop the head)



- 7. Reverse this procedure to re-install the head.
- 8. Once the unit has passed a visual inspection, shut and secure the SSIU door.
- 9. Return power to the unit and follow the restart procedure.
